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**COMPLAINT**

The Plaintiff, JACQUELINE RAMIREZ, sues the Defendant, WALT DISNEY WORLD CO. d/b/a DISNEY'S CORONADO SPRINGS RESORT, and alleges:


1. This is an action for damages that exceeds \$15,000, exclusive of interest, costs and attorney's fees.
2. On or about July 22, 2013, Defendant was the owner and operator of the Coronado Springs Resort in Lake Buena Vista, Florida.
3. At that time and place, Plaintiff, Jacqueline Ramirez was a guest at Defendant's hotel and fell as a result of a dangerous, slippery condition of a walkway on Defendant's premises.
4. The Defendant was negligent in causing Plaintiff's fall in that:
  - a) It knew of the slippery condition of the walkway; and/or
  - b) It should have known of the slippery condition of the walkway in the exercise of reasonable care; and/or
  - c) It failed to warn or alert Plaintiff of the slippery condition of the walkway; and/or
  - d) The walkway was maintained or constructed in such a manner that its surface became extremely slippery when wet or moist and Defendant should have ensured that the texture of the walkway was such that it would not be slippery when wet.
5. As a result of the negligence of the Defendant, Plaintiff suffered permanent bodily injuries, resulting pain and suffering, disability, disfigurement, inconvenience, mental anguish, loss

of capacity for the enjoyment of life, expense of hospitalization, medical and nursing care treatment and treatment, loss of earnings, loss of ability to earn money in the future and/or permanent aggravation of a previously existing condition. As the injuries are permanent, Plaintiff will suffer damages in the future.

WHEREFORE Plaintiff demands judgment against Defendant for compensatory damages and further demands a trial by jury of all issues so triable.
